RESOLUTION 26-25

Authorization to Amend the Funding for Construction Services during the
Construction of the Cottonwood Creek downstream of Briarwood Avenue
Stream Reclamation Improvements

WHEREAS, the Cottonwood Creek downstream of Briarwood Avenue Stream Reclamation Improvements (the Project) were identified in the draft study titled "Cherry Creek Southwest Tributaries Major Drainageway Plan" by Wright Water Engineers, Inc., dated January 2024 (the Plan); and

WHEREAS, the instability of Cottonwood Creek between Briarwood Avenue and Arapahoe Road has resulted in severe erosion that puts existing infrastructure, structures, and floodplain capacity at risk; and

WHEREAS, the Project is needed to address channel and bank instability within the Project limits; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 24-31 established the design budget for the Project to be \$264,612, which included 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the additional CLOMR permitting services and engineering services during construction for the Project has been estimated to be \$159,554.25; and

WHEREAS, it is typical to budget an additional ten (10) percent (\$15,955.00) of the cost of services to cover contingencies that may be encountered during construction; and

WHEREAS, SEMSWA has adopted a budget for calendar year 2026 subsequent to public hearing, which includes funds for the design and construction of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board authorizes the Executive Director to enter into contracts on behalf of SEMSWA for the additional design and construction support services of the Project.
2. The design and construction support services funding for the Project is limited to \$440,121.25 without prior approval of the Board.

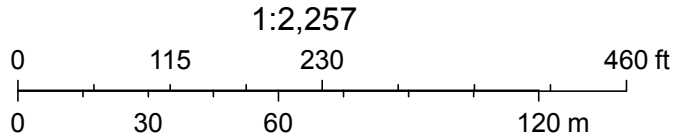
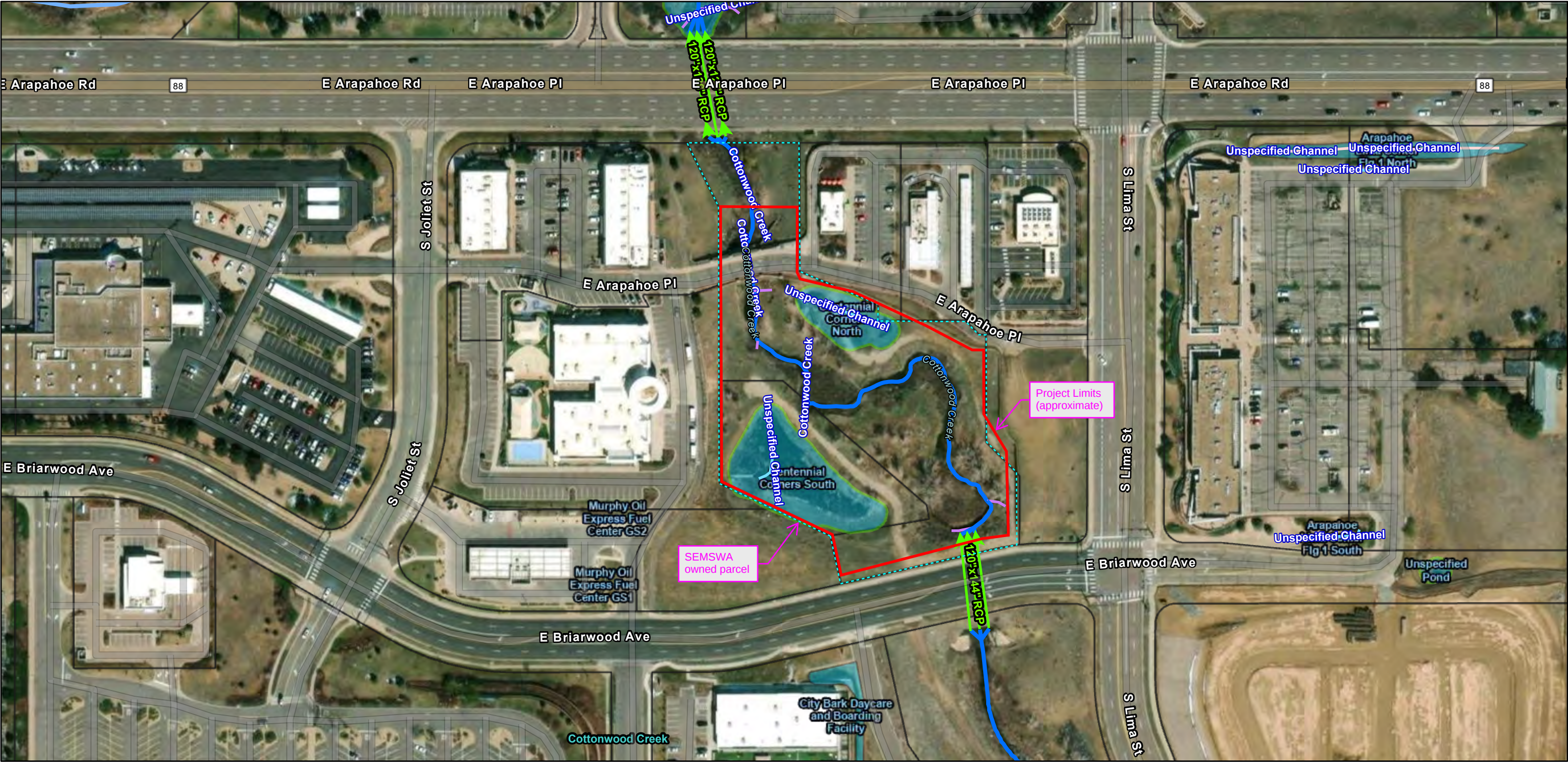
