- 1. Section F-4a. - Because CIPP is a special-order design and manufactured material, what is SEMSWA's expectation for turn around time from pricing the project to delivering and installing the material?**

Due to the special nature of CIPP, SEMSWA understands that these special-order manufactured materials are subject to a project-specific scope and schedule. SEMSWA will work with the F-4 contractor on a case-by-case basis with regard to turn-around time from pricing to project delivery and installation.

- 2. Section F-4b and c. – If new installation or point repairs of storm sewers is part of Section F-4, would SEMSWA go directly to the Section F-1 Construction on call contractors for pricing? Or, would the CIPP contractor (those who do not self-perform excavation work) either - a) have access to and be required to use the already approved F1 contractors, or b) can solicit other non-SEMSWA approved excavation contractors to perform the necessary work under the F-4 category.**

Approved F-4 Contractors are not required to use short-listed F-1 Contractors and may solicit other non-SEMSWA approved contractors as necessary, provided that the sub-contractors are licensed to work in the jurisdiction where the work is being performed.
