A separate permit may be required for other improvements and may include Street Cut and/or Right-Of-Way (ROW) Use Permits.

PERMIT SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The GESC Annual Permit will be applied for at the beginning of each calendar year and will expire on December 31st of the same year.
2. The Permit Fee must be paid prior to issuing the permit. No refunds will be made.
3. The Annual Permit consists of this signed permit, a GESC Typical Plan and Standard Notes, GESC Best Management Practice (BMP) Details, and GESC Considerations Fact Sheet.
4. A list of all contractors acting on behalf of the Owner within SEMSWA Service Area will be provided to SEMSWA, including all contact information.
5. Construction will be completed by contractor crews trained in grading, erosion and sediment controls. It is the responsibility of the Owner to ensure that the contractor has reviewed and is familiar with the SEMSWA GESC Program and its requirements. A GESC Manager will be assigned at each construction site to be responsible for installing, maintaining, and removing BMP controls. The GESC Manager will be the primary contact person in charge of coordinating/monitoring/enforcing the GESC Annual Permit requirements.
6. The GESC Typical Plan Details and standard notes, prepared by SEMSWA, is part of the Annual Permit application and will be used to guide the implementation of BMPs.
7. It is anticipated that SEMSWA BMP Details will be applied to all projects. In the event that an equivalent BMP, not a SEMSWA BMP Detail, is used and is found to be ineffective, the SEMSWA Detail will be installed.
8. If SEMSWA determines that the requirements of the Annual Permit are not fulfilled, the contractor will be notified, and the deficiency corrected immediately. Corrections and/or modifications to the onsite BMPs as requested by SEMSWA will be completed in accordance with the GESC Typical Plan/Detail. The Owner will also be notified of non-compliance. Enforcement may be initiated upon identification of deficiencies.
9. Final establishment of vegetation for all projects will meet the coverage requirements of the GESC Manual. Upon completion of construction, the site will be returned to its original condition or better.
10. Activities carried out under this Annual Permit may not render ineffective, the existing erosion and or sediment control BMPs for a site that has other construction activities on-going. Should any BMPs for the site be rendered ineffective, the Owner will ensure that the contractor repairs or replaces the affected BMPs. For BMPs that include seed or sod, maintenance will be provided, including any watering necessary to insure the establishment of the sod or seed.
11. Sediment in the flow line or tracking in the street right-of-way will be minimized, and mitigated upon discovery. Street sweeping and or other BMPs will be used as necessary to ensure that sediment does not enter the storm water system, during or following construction. The street may be swept throughout the day and at the end of each working day at minimum, but if tracking is identified, sweeping must be implemented immediately and continue until such time that tracking is no longer identified as a potential pollutant source. Enforcement may be initiated upon identification of tracking issues and may escalate at SEMSWA's discretion.
12. Any groundwater encountered or expected to be encountered that will be discharged off of a project site will require a Colorado Discharge Permit System, Construction Dewatering Permit (CDW). This includes groundwater that is comingled with stormwater or surface water. The CDW permit requirements will be followed to reduce the amount of and/or eliminate sediment allowed to discharge from dewatering activities.
13. Good housekeeping practices will be used at construction sites. This includes proper storage of hazardous materials, waste disposal, equipment and material storage, fueling procedures, spill response and material recovery.
14. The use of hoses and water to flush or wash any material into a storm sewer is prohibited. The material must be recovered using dry recovery methods. Any material resulting from saw cutting or potholing activities must be recovered using dry recovery techniques (not flushing). Vacuuming while saw cutting is recommended.
15. This Annual Permit is revocable. Failure to comply with these Terms and Special Conditions may result in the revocation of the Annual Permit. A request for Annual Permit reissuance will include, but may not be limited to, re-payment of Annual Permit fees.
16. Failure to obtain an Annual Permit for construction activities will be considered enforceable.

By signing below Owner certifies the following: *The information provided on this application is factual to the best of my knowledge. I understand that this permit is granted under the special conditions listed above. I also understand that the Typical Plan and standard notes, BMP details and GESC Considerations Fact Sheet will provide the basis for contractor compliance under this permit. I further understand that it is my responsibility to ensure the contractor is aware of GESC requirements and capable of fulfilling these special conditions on my behalf. I agree that all applicable city and state permits have been obtained or will be obtained prior to commencing construction.*
